



Come and join in the fun at the Augusta Players Summer Theatre Camp! The camp is a two-week program for children ages 6 to 18 years. Two sessions are available: Session 1, Monday, June 15th-Friday, June 26th, meeting at Martinez Baptist Church, 3632 Lynnwood Drive; and Session 2, Monday, July 13th-Friday, July 24th, meeting at Crossbridge Baptist Church 3130 Skinner Mill Road, Augusta. A showcase of skills learned is planned for the last Friday of each session, at 6:30pm. Enrollment in all camp sessions is limited and classes are filled in the order in which applications are received.

Student Age: 6-8 years

Hours: 10am-2:15pm

Through song, dance, and games the students will be introduced to the excitement of drama and the fun of putting together and performing a musical scene.

Student Age: 9-11 years

The students will develop their expressive abilities and learn about acting, voice, and movement while developing a musical scene for presentation. They will also have experience with make-up, making props and set pieces, creativity/improvisational games, and stage choreography.

Student Age: Middle School- High School

Hours: 10:00am-2:15 pm

Fee: \$200.00 (includes t-shirt)

This group will learn how to develop a character while acting, singing & dancing. They will also learn how to apply make-up and special make-up effects, develop scenery and costumes that are appropriate to the scene and develop choreography. Specialty classes can include stage combat, makeup and costume & scenic design. Putting all of these skills together they will rehearse and present a musical scene.

Student Age: Middle School-High School

Master Class

Hours: 10:00am-3:00pm

Fee: \$210.00 (includes t-shirt)

This is a master level course for those who have previously been involved in several productions at the community or high school level. Classes will concentrate on honing already learned skills, auditioning techniques, character development, and how to “sell” a song onstage. Movement classes and combat skills will be included as well as costume plots, makeup design, lighting and sound. This group will perform in the showcase on Friday.
