Each year our summer camps provide theatrical training in a fun atmosphere for children 6 to teen. ## CAMP INFO

Join in the fun at the Augusta Players Summer Theatre Camp! Each camp is a two-week program for children ages 6 to 14. Two sessions are available: Session 1, Monday, June 25<sup>th</sup>-Friday, July 6<sup>th</sup> and Session 2, Monday, July 16<sup>th</sup>-Friday, July 27<sup>th</sup>. Both camps will be held at The Church of the Good Shepherd on Walton Way. There will be an evening showcase of learned skills and a morning Talent Show at the end of each session. Each camper will receive a camp tshirt which is included in the fee.

## FEES

Each session, you pay only **\$225** for the entire two weeks! A Master Class is available for an additional **\$50** for those who qualify (see Master Class details.)

## WHAT THEY LEARN

Through song, dance and games all students will be introduced to the excitement of drama and the fun of putting together and performing a musical scene. The students will develop their expressive abilities while learning about acting, voice, and movement in age-level appropriate activities. They will also have experience with make-up, making props and set pieces, creativity/improvisational games, and stage choreography. Special emphasis will be placed on singing and dancing.

Putting all of these skills together they will rehearse and present a showcase of what they have learned. This showcase will take place on the second Thursday evening at 6:00 pm.

The final Friday morning of each session, there will be an auditioned Talent Show. Campers will choose their performance piece, with the assistance of a camp counselor, which they will then perform for their peers.

If time permits, there will be a water fun play after the Talent Show.

## MASTER CLASS

This add-on is for middle and high school campers who have had previous stage experience. In the Master Class, led by one of our lead teachers, they will learn audition skills and how to create a bio and portfolio. They also receive a student makeup kit.
