

Debi Ballas Performing Arts Scholarship  
Through The Augusta Players

Description:

This scholarship is awarded to a graduating high school senior to recognize his or her service to The Augusta Players and their community and to encourage continued growth in supporting the arts.

Value:

One scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.00. Please note that scholarships will be paid with a check made out to the recipient's school of choice.

Eligibility:

- The applicant must have participated in at least one production, special event or fundraiser with The Augusta Players or The Augusta Jr. Players.
- The applicant must be a graduating high school senior.
- The applicant must be planning on continuing his or her education. Additional points are given if further study is in the arts.
- The applicant must complete an essay about the importance of the arts in education.
- The applicant must have demonstrated the capacity to contribute to society as shown by activities and personal recommendations.
- The applicant must obtain three personal recommendations.
  - One of these recommendations must come from a teacher concerning their academic abilities.
  - One of these recommendations must come from a director or other creative team member concerning their arts based contributions or abilities. It can be contained in the same recommendation from a teacher concerning academic abilities.
  - The other recommendation letters must be written by supervising adults not directly related to the applicant concerning his or her character and support of, or involvement in the arts.

Basis of Award:

Award will be based on academic standards and character qualities reflected in the applicant's letters of recommendation and application. The applicant's dedication, participation and support of the arts and The Augusta Players will also be considered. There are additional considerations given to applicants continuing their education in the arts. Applications will be adjudicated by a committee of no less than 5 volunteers. An example of the scoring sheet is attached to the end this application.

Application procedure:

1. Download and complete the application form provided. Please be sure to complete all of the questions or the application becomes void.
2. Obtain three letters of recommendation and attach them to your application.
3. Completed applications, essays and recommendation letters must be returned to [info@augustaplayers.org](mailto:info@augustaplayers.org) by May 3, 2021. The winner will be notified by May 17, 2021 and the scholarship presented virtually in late May / early June.
